

**PLAY IT SAFE! THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE FOR THE PROTECTION
AND ENJOYMENT OF ALL MEMBERS, GUESTS AND RENTERS.**

This is a private club owned and operated by Big Boulder Lake LLC.

General Rules

- Each Guest must have a pass and check into the club office daily. Wristbands will be given and **MUST** be worn and **visible** at all times. If you are not wearing a wristband you will be asked to leave the club immediately.
- No children under the age of 15 are allowed on club property without a supervising adult.
- Designated parking for the Lake Club is in the Parking Lot next to the Tennis Courts. DO NOT park in Tavern Parking Lot.
- **Alcohol is prohibited on Club property. Visibly intoxicated persons WILL be asked to leave Club property. Repeat offenders WILL have membership revoked.**
- **Pets are not allowed on Club property. Service dogs are welcomed.**
- Glass/Chinaware is not permitted on club property.
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.
- Swimming is permitted in designated areas only. **There is no swimming off boats or outside of the swim area.**
- When Club is closed – **There will be NO Trespassing. Members or their guests caught trespassing on Club Property will be asked to leave. Repeat offenders will have their membership revoked.**
- **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GRANTED FOR A REVOKED PASS...**

Swimming/Beach/Pool Area

- No lifeguard on duty; swimming is at your own risk.
- **No swimming outside of designated swim area.**
- No running, dunking, pushing or other horseplay is permitted. Enter the pool with caution at all times. The pools and lake are shallow and **NO DIVING** in pool or lake is permitted. The Swim rope is not a toy – please keep your children off the rope.
- Flotation devices may be used with the approval of the Office. Non-swimmers may use a flotation device provided he/she is accompanied by a guardian swimmer.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) who shall be responsible for the child's behavior and compliance with all pool regulations and rules. No children under 15 years of age are allowed on property without an adult.
- Babies and toddlers must wear plastic pants or appropriate swim diapers in all pools.
- Non-swimming younger children may be in the large pool only if accompanied by a parent or guardian swimmer.
- The Manager on duty may close the pool during scheduled hours for reasons of safety, weather or maintenance.
- Management/Staff have discretionary authority in establishing and administering safety regulations.
- No Pool Chairs are to be removed from the Pool Deck.
- Proper bathing attire is required. No topless bathing is permitted.

Fishing/Boating/Lake Area

- All Commonwealth of PA Boating and Fishing Commission rules and regulations apply.
- Diving, jumping and swimming from boats is strictly prohibited.
- Boats must be registered at the Boulder Lake Club office and display proper state and Club identification.
- Only electric powered motors are permitted on Big Boulder Lake and must display current PA fish and boat commission power boat registration.
- Inflatable crafts must be USCG approved and be a minimum of 8 feet in length, with a minimum of 3 independent chambers.
- SUP's are regulated for one person only. Only one person is permitted per board on our lake.
- USCG approved wearable personal flotation devices are required for each occupant. Children age 12 and under MUST wear an appropriately sized life jacket.
- In the event of severe or inclement weather, all boats are to exit to the closest shore. This is for your safety!
- All Bass must be catch and release. There is no harvest of bass.
- No limit for pan fish. Good sportsmanship requires that an injured fish not be returned to the lake.
- Fishing is not permitted from docks, swimming/beach areas, shoreline on or near the dam breast. Fishing is permitted from Boats ONLY. Any person caught fishing from the shoreline will be prosecuted.
- Persons age 16 and older must possess a current Pennsylvania fishing license.
- All Persons on the lake outside of the swim area must stay on their boat/board. **The islands are off limits.**

Tennis

- Reservations recommended.
- Appropriate tennis footwear (i.e., tennis shoes, sneakers) must be worn on any tennis court. Absolutely NO flip-flops! In the event of questionable attire and footwear, the decision of management is final.
- Only persons actually engaged in play may be on the tennis courts (maximum of 4).
- Please do not interrupt play on the adjacent court by walking onto the other court, retrieving a ball or disruptive noise or behavior.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
- Club Management reserves the right to ask anyone to leave whose behavior or attire is not acceptable to Club standards.
